ROSAARY PATCH SERIES FOR FIRST THRU FIFTH GRADES

This Rosary patch series is a new program designed to encourage youth to learn more about their faith and pray the rosary. The requirements in this brochure are meant for 1st thru 5th graders. Once the requirements are completed you can place an order with your local Diocesan Catholic Committee for Girl Scouts & Camp Fire for that patch section. It is not necessary to send in the completed form. Adults can verify the correctness of the answers.

This Rosary Patch series consists of a 5 section Patch. The center patch depicts Our Lady of Fatima and is earned by doing the Praying the Rosary section. For each of the Mysteries there is a rocker which goes around the center patch.

We strongly encourage the youth to do all of the requirements to get the most out of the program, however we do not wish to make it too difficult to complete. First thru Third graders must complete five requirements for each section. Fourth thru fifth graders should complete all of the requirements. A Basic Bible will prove to be an excellent resource.
